Kinesiology and Health Science course requirements	Yes plus 4 program courses (1 full + 6 half year courses)	Yes plus 4 ATC courses (1 full + 6 half year courses)
Number of years of commitment to the program	Depends on year of entry	3 years except in special cases of advanced standing
Hours of commitment outside class time	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 30 hr/term in final year 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • field and clinical placements required • 1200 hours needed for CATA examination




