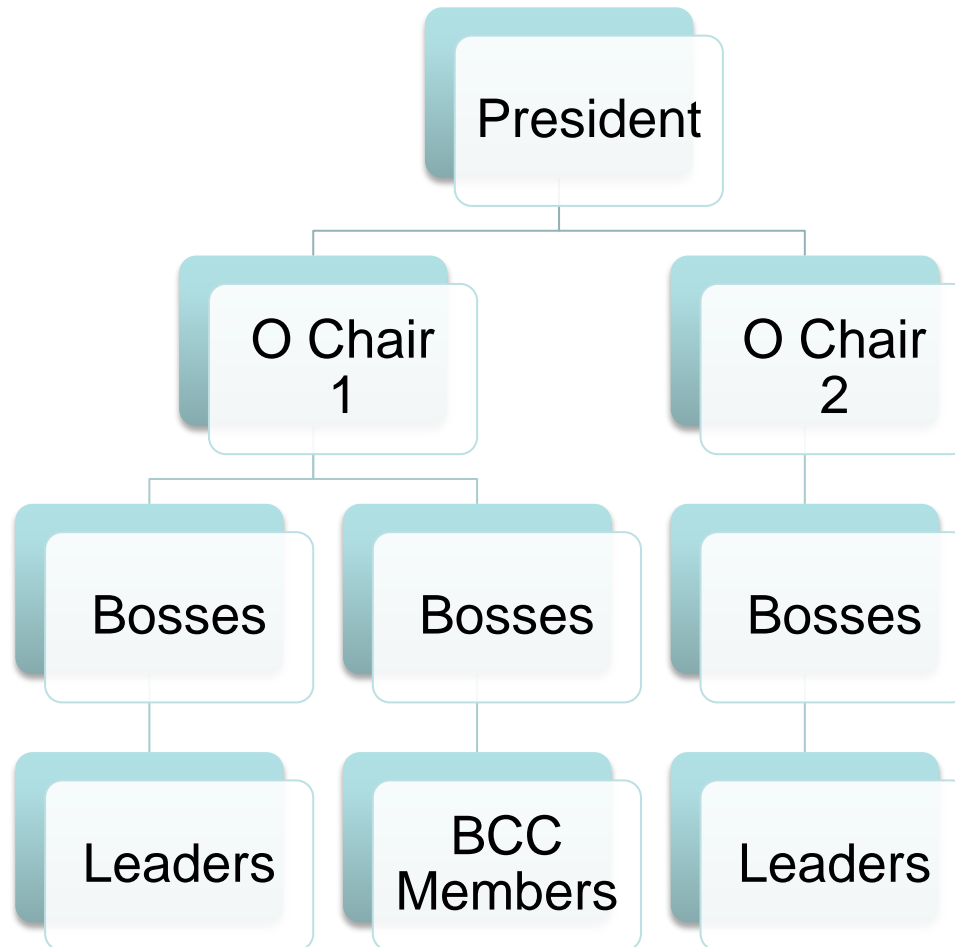

Part I

Frosh Chain of Command



1. Enhancing Froshies' Experience



- Frosh is all about the **Froshies**
- Our objective: help Froshies transition
- Make impressionable and lasting connections with Froshies



2. Respect



- Respect your bosses no matter their year of study
- Respect your Froshies
- Respect other FLs



3. Stations



- When assigned to a station, it is your **RESPONSIBILITY** to hold your position
- You will be placed in pairs and rotate every hour



4. Walk-backs



- This is a **MUST** for all FLs
- Make sure Froshies get to their destination *safely*

Boundaries



- Boundaries are important rules and guidelines that should be established in order to maintain a **positive** and **safe** environment.
- If you do not set strict boundaries, many of the benefits of the student-frosh leader relationship will be LOST!

Respect Boundaries



- **No personal contact information (emails, phone numbers, social media)**
- **No inappropriate physical contact**
- **Always travel in pairs when escorting a Froshie**
- **Always use appropriate language**
- **No dating Froshies during Frosh week**
- **No \$\$\$ transferring hands**

Dos

- Assist Froshies to transition into university life
- Wear your jersey at all times and attend all events
- Follow the directions of the President, O Chairs and Bosses
- Direct Froshies to important services offered by Bethune College and York <http://bethune.yorku.ca/services/>
- Establish a positive, appropriate relationship with your Froshies
- Help your Froshies develop pride in York and Bethune College



Don'ts

- Don't touch/date your Froshies
- Don't lend money
- Don't talk about ([REDACTED]) to the Froshies
- Don't provide your personal home or cell phone number
- Don't make decisions for your Froshies
- Don't be a personal therapist
- Don't verbally abuse your Froshie
- Don't accept money or gifts from your Froshie
