



WHAT IS SECOND ENTRY NURSING PROGRAM?

2nd Entry Nursing Program is a compressed or an accelerated Bachelor's Program offered to students with some undergraduate credits or an undergraduate degree

Goal = to become a Registered Nurse (RN)

OTHER PATHWAYS TO BECOMING A RN

 Four-year Bachelor's Degree in Nursing (BScN) if you are not qualified for the 2nd entry

 Go from LPN (Licensed Practical Nurse) to RN (Registered Nurse) through specific college programs



SCHOOLING OPTIONS

 There are 10 universities in Ontario that offer Secondary Entry or Compressed Program in Nursing

ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS

- Various set of requirements.
- Prerequisites equivalency at specific university is important.
- Example of pre-requisites you might need:
 - Biology (University level)
 - Human Physiology and/or Anatomy or a full credit of Physiology only
 - Biochemistry and/or Microbiology
 - Nutrition
 - Statistics and/or Research Methods
 - Humanities and/or Philosophy
 - Social Science and/or Psychology
 - Overall B average of 2-3 years undergraduate study and/or 30.0 most recent credits***
 - ***Meeting the minimum GPA does not guarantee an admission, some institutions are very competitive.

- Specialized Honours- 150 credits
- Faculty of Health, School of Nursing
- Must fulfill:
- Required GPA & number of credits
- Prerequisite courses
- Additional Requirements

GPA & CREDITS

- Cumulative GPA of at LEAST a B (6.0 on York Scale) and a B+ (7.0) average in the last recent 30 credits
- Minimum of 60 credits at a recognized university
- Pre-requisites Equivalency List

Prerequisite Courses	Credits
Psychology	6 credits OR two 3 credit courses
Human Anatomy and Physiology	6 credits OR 3 credits in Human Anatomy and 3 credits in Human Physiology
Microbiology*	3 credits
Statistics	3 credits
Philosophy	3 credits
Humanities (English, fine arts, history, literature, religion, philosophy, classics, drama, linguistics)	3 credits

9 credits at the 3000 level are required, can include any of the prerequisite courses.

- The Nursing Department at York can provide you with a document as to which courses fulfill certain listed prerequisites.
- Stay up to date as requirements may be altered/added at different times
- Apply on time!
- The application deadline is February 1, 2021 for admission to the Program in September 2021.

LAWRENCE S. BLOOMBERG FACULTY OF NURSING AT UNIVERSITY OF TORONTO

- 2 year program Full time
- Completed 10 university full courses with a minimum 3.0 GPA (mid B)
- In those 10 courses, a max of six 1000 level
- One full course equivalent in Human Physiology (Kine 2011 and Kine 3012), Life Science, Social Science and Humanities
- Half course in Statistics

Supplementary Application

- Personal statement (goals, nursing knowledge, and thoughts on health care)
- One Academic Reference
- One work-related reference for admissions assessment
- English Requirement (for ESL students)
- A personal interview may be required

HUMBER COLLEGE- NORTH CAMPUS

- Partnership with the University of New Brunswick has ended
- Humber plans to have its own standalone Bachelor of Science in Nursing
- Humber application is still in progress, if approved Humber will open applications to Second Entry preparation program for September 2021

TRENT UNIVERSITY- FLEMING SCHOOL OF NURSING

- Compressed program (28 months) Full time
- Minimum GPA of 2.7 (70%) in the last 10 university full courses (2 years of university)
- Casper required (takecasper.com)
- In those courses you need:
 - Biology (60%)
 - Chemistry (60%)
 - Math (60%)
 - One half course in Intro Psychology (3 credits)
 - Two half courses of 1000 level (6 credits)
 - One half course of 2000 level (3 credits)

WESTERN UNIVERSITY-ARTHUR LABATT FAMILY SCHOOL OF NURSING

- 19-month program
- 5 consecutive terms
- Only offers full-time
- 104 students are accepted per year



WESTERN UNIVERSITY-ARTHUR LABATT FAMILY SCHOOL OF NURSING

- Completed at least 10 university full-course equivalents
- Minimum GPA (75%) in the last 10 university courses or the last 2 years
- Required to complete Casper Test
 - Minimum grade of 60% in:
 - Physiology full credit (Kine 2011 and Kine 3012)
 - Anatomy (half credit)
 - Statistics (half credit)



WESTERN UNIVERSITY-ARTHUR LABATT FAMILY SCHOOL OF NURSING

Students applying should at least satisfy one following criteria:

- I. English as a first language
- For ESL: The applicant has to write additional tests (before March).
 Refer to website for more information.
- TOEFL: 580 paper based; 237 computer-based and TSE (Test of Spoken English) 50 or greater; Internet-based-total score of 92-93, with 22-24 in writing, 26 in speaking, 20 in reading, and 20 in listening
- <u>IELTS</u>: 7, with at least 6.5 in reading and listening and at least 7 in writing and speaking
