- Concerned with the treatment of a broad range of
 - Speech
 - Language
 - Voice
 - Swallowing
 - Cognitive-communication impairment
- Functional & structural
 - Stroke
 - Head injury
 - Cancer of head and neck

SLP General Admission Requirements

- University Bachelor Degree
- Course prerequisites
 - Linguistics, child development, human physiology, phonetics, research methods, statistics
 - Obtain at least B+ in all the required courses
- Last final year (or last 5 full courses) in mid-B standing
- At least 14 hours of experience by a speech language pathologist
- 2 academic reference letters by full-time faculty members
- Clinical reference form and reference letter
- Personal Statement

Developmental psychology, human physiology/human anatomy, statistics Obtain at least B+ in all the required courses

Have a GPA of at least B in the last 10 full courses (last 2 years)

Personal Statement

2 letters of reference

14 hours of volunteer experiences under an audiologist

Clinical reference letter from audiologist

Cardiovascular perfusion

Supports the normal functioning of the heart and lungs during open-heart surgery, enabling the heart to stop in order to perform cardiac surgery Conducting cardio-pulmonary bypass using a heart-lung machine and other equipment
